Purpose of Sponsorship Request

Juneau Dance Theatre (JDT) has been a part of the Juneau community since 1975. We are proud of the cultural opportunities we provide, such as regular season performance programs, year round training in classical ballet and other styles of dance, a robust summer intensive program, educational seminars, and the annual summer Fine Arts Camp. JDT strives to be among the principal nonprofit arts organizations in Juneau.

Since 2004, JDT has presented *The Nutcracker* at the Juneau Douglas High School Auditorium. This annual holiday tradition and commitment to the community provides Juneau dancers the opportunity to perform, while enriching their passion for the art. The program attracts nearly 2,000 audience members and has become a magical event for Juneau families. Each year, JDT also provides a special performance – free of charge – to more than 900 elementary students from the Juneau School District, as part of JDT's community outreach program. For many children, this is their first experience attending a full-length ballet. Beginning in 2018, JDT became a proud partner of the Kennedy Center's *Any Given Child* national initiative, through which we conducted classroom visits, interactive learning about ballet, and a free performance our Spring Showcase, to every sixth grader in Juneau. In 2019, we opened up that opportunity to interested third graders, as well.

This year's *The Nutcracker* will feature guest artists from the Pacific Northwest Ballet (PNB), one of the premiere professional ballet companies on the west coast, and in the nation. Elizabeth Murphy and Jerome Tisserand, principal dancers with PNB, will share the stage with our JDT students to enhance the quality of the production, and inspire our dancers and audiences. As our student base continues to grow, this year's *The Nutcracker* boasts a cast of nearly 90 participants! JDT does a good job sustaining with its tuition fees, admissions revenues and fundraising efforts, however we face escalating costs to produce *The Nutcracker*, such as auditorium rental fees, advertising, printing, and set and costume maintenance. Without the generosity of sponsors, we would not be able to keep our admission prices low enough to ensure that ALL families can afford to attend our productions.

Last season, JDT added a full length story ballet, *Snow White*, to our spring showcase. The performances were successful, the dancing exquisite, and mounting a full-length production, complete with costumes, scenery, and original choreography, was a good way for JDT to stretch its wings and grow. We hope to perform another full-length ballet in the near future. For spring of 2020, audiences can look forward to a mixed repertory, including excerpts from a popular classical ballet, and an original work, choreographed in collaboration with one of Juneau's most respected, and well-loved composers, Todd Hunt.

Your contribution will support all JDT performances, in addition to our outreach program and tuition scholarships for students in need. Additional opportunities for our students, such as access to professional pointe shoe fitters, guest teachers, and educational seminars will also be funded in part through your generous donation.

We take great care to maintain and extend the life of our costume inventory; however, frequent alterations and wear and tear eventually take a toll and then it's time to replace. Each year we try to replace selected characters or groups of characters in the ballet, to give our performances a fresh, and updated look for our dancers, and our audience.

Your individual and/or business name will be credited *in all future programs** for the prop, costume, and/or scenery you choose to sponsor (*for at least three years, or as long as the piece is still in use.)
