


A huge thank you to all our staff, faculty, students, families, volunteers, Board of Directors, crew, and guest artists! None of this would be possible without you.

#### About Juneau Dance Theatre

Juneau Dance Theatre (JDT) was founded in 1975, by a small group of individuals, committed to dance education. Until then, no formal dance training had been available to Juneau residents. JDT, then known as Juneau Dance Unlimited, hosted inspiring workshops and provided professional dance instruction.

In 1977, the Juneau Dance Festival was created, bringing guest artists to Juneau to teach a month of technique and repertory classes to children and adults. In 1990, visual arts classes were added and the next year, music and theatre classes were also offered. Over the next several decades, this program evolved into the popular and beloved multi-disciplinary, *Juneau Fine Arts Camp*, offered each June, to K-6 graders.

JDT changed its focus in 1992, moving towards the establishment of a permanent, non-profit dance school taught by local instructors. JDT began offering year-round dance training, and the studio grew in size and scope, eventually moving from a downtown location at the Scottish Rite Temple, to its current location in the valley above Alaska Litho.

In 2021 the organization took a step toward realizing expansion goals envisioned by its leadership, by leasing a second studio space, hiring additional instructional faculty, and creating four distinct divisions of the school. JDT combined resources with the former Fusion Dance Company, to establish a Dance Team Division, Recreational Division, and Adult Division, complementing its existing Professional Ballet Division. Today, JDT serves approximately 160 students with classes in all levels of ballet, a full progression of young dancer classes, multiple dance teams, and adult and recreational classes. In addition to its own performance season, JDT proudly collaborates with other community arts organizations and artists, including Orpheus Project, Theater Alaska, the Juneau Arts and Humanities Council, Juneau Symphony, and Juneau Lyric Opera.

JDT's mission is to nurture artistry, confidence, discipline, and mental and physical strength through quality dance training and performance.

Through our outreach programs, we strive to bring dance into the community, encouraging education and appreciation. Each year JDT provides elementary school students the opportunity to attend free performances. Our robust scholarship program for our year-round classes, workshops, and summer programs, ensures all children have the opportunity to participate, regardless of their ability to pay.







#### ZACHARY HENCH Artistic Director

Originally from Loysville, Pennsylvania, Mr. Hench began his training at Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet where he studied for eight years. He attended summer intensives at the School of American Ballet in New York and completed his pre-professional education at the Kirov Academy of Ballet in Washington D.C. Mr. Hench danced as a principal with Boston Ballet, San Francisco Ballet,

and Pennsylvania Ballet. Over the course of his 22 year career, he performed leading roles in ballets such as *Swan Lake*, *Giselle*, *Le Corsaire*, *La Sylphide*, *Romeo and Juliet*, *Cinderella*, and *La Fille mal gardée*. His extensive neoclassical and contemporary repertoire included works by George Balanchine, William Forsythe, and Nacho Duato, among many others. Mr. Hench originated roles in ballets by choreographers such as Christopher Wheeldon, Twyla Tharp, and Helgi Tomasson, and performed throughout the world as a guest artist. He has coached students for performances and competitions, and has been invited to teach master classes and summer intensives across the country.

Mr. Hench served as a union delegate while dancing at Pennsylvania Ballet, facilitating communication between dancers and management and representing his colleagues during contract negotiations. The company then invited Mr. Hench to join the artistic staff as Ballet Master, and he successfully led the organization through a critical period of internal transitions. Mr. Hench now leads JDT as Artistic Director, and can be credited for much of the organization's growth since 2015, including establishing a boys' scholarship program, in an attempt to recruit and retain more male dancers wishing to study ballet. He regularly invites world renown guest artists and faculty, to travel to Juneau to work with, and alongside JDT's students.

He is married to Julie Diana, Executive Director of American Repertory Ballet, and the Princeton Ballet School, with whom he has two children.

### **BRIDGET LUJAN Executive Director**

Bridget Lujan earned a BFA in Theatre from Niagara University, in New York, and has a deep connection to the arts in Juneau which includes performing with Perseverance Theatre, Juneau Lyric Opera, Juneau Douglas Little Theatre (now known as Juneau Ghostlight Theatre). While her responsibilities at JDT primarily fall under her role as Executive Director, she loves teaching tap - especially to children - and has been thrilled



to be back in the studio for the last year as an instructor. Bridget has choreographed musical theatre productions with Theater at Latitude 58, the JDHS Drama Department, and other schools and arts groups.

Bridget has led the organization alongside Artistic Director, Zachary Hench, since 2018, and is responsible for daily operations, including management of assets, finance, public relations, administrative staffing, and event production.

Prior to accepting the Executive Director position, Bridget served as JDT's board treasurer from 2013-2017, and many different volunteer prior to that, including costuming (which she still enjoys, but only because of the amazing volunteers and friends who lighten the load!), and fund development efforts. "Way back when", she began her journey as an instructor with the organization (then Juneau Dance Unlimited), upon arriving in Juneau in 1995.

Outside of JDT, Bridget is a licensed CPA who specializes in tax planning and preparation, and business consulting. Throughout her career she has gained expertise in accounting and compliance in the private and non-profit sectors. In 2018, Bridget started her own accounting firm, Bridget Lujan, CPA (formerly R. Daniel MacLeod, CPA). She is a past trustee and treasurer for the Juneau Arts and Humanities Council and a long-time member and past president of the Rotary Club of Juneau; and was active as a parent volunteer with Boy Scouts, Alaska Youth Choir, Southeast Alaska Gymnastics Academy and of course, JDT, for many years. Bridget is married to Jess Lujan (who also happens to adore volunteering for JDT, as do their adult children, and extended family members, etc.)



#### CATHERINE O'DAY Principal Teacher and Ballet Master

Catherine is JDT's Principal Teacher and Ballet Master. Prior to coming to Juneau in 2017, Catherine served as associate artistic director of Central Texas Youth Ballet and was on the teaching faculty for Eglevsky Ballet in New York, under the direction of Laszlo Berdo. Catherine trained with Leslie Hench at Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet, in addition to attending programs at Virginia School of the Arts and University of

North Carolina School of the Arts. She teaches Level 2 through Level 6, and all levels of pointe and variations. Catherine regularly choreographs original pieces for our Spring Showcases. She is responsible for rehearsing all ballet choreography for JDT performances, and works closely with the Artistic Director on curriculum and programming needs. As JDT's Outreach Coordinator, Catherine develops interactive and educational materials, and plans for school classroom visits. School visits have included those conducted as part of an arts excursion for sixth-graders, in partnership with Any Given Child.

## JANICE HURLEY JDT Faculty, Young Dancers, Contemporary

Janice Hurley received her teaching credentials from the University of Minnesota and her Bachelor of Arts in Theatre Arts from Jacksonville University in Florida. She has taught in both academic and performing arts venues. She has performed, choreographed, and directed in a variety of dance art styles. A Juneau resident since the mid-nineties, Janice has participated in projects with Northern Lights Junior Theatre, Theater at



Latitude 58, Juneau Lyric Opera, Perseverance Theatre, and the Juneau School District. She was the Assistant Director of Gold Creek Child Development Center from 2001-2004. She was the Artistic Director of Juneau Dance Theatre from 2004 through June of 2011. Janice continues to teach the children's dance program for JRC-The Alaska Club and work with various educational and performing groups in Juneau. In May, 2015, Janice received her Master of Arts Degree in Early Childhood Development in the Performing Arts from Lesley University in Cambridge, Massachusetts.

#### JUAN CASTELLANOS Guest Artist

Juan Rafael Castellanos is very excited to be returning as a guest artist for Juneau Dance Theater's (JDT) production of "Alice in Wonderland"! Juan's JDT debut was in 2019 as the role of Prince Charming in Laszlo Berdo's "Snow White". Juan's dance training began in Dublin, Ireland, where he was born and continued in the U.S. at Metropolitan Ballet Academy in Jenkintown, PA under the Direction of Lisa Collins Vidnovic. As a



member of their nationally acclaimed Boys' scholarship Program, Juan's 11 years of study there included access to many world-class teachers and the opportunity to perform a variety of principal roles in both classical ballets and contemporary. After graduation in 2019, Juan then joined the Charlotte Ballet Pre-Professional program under the Direction of Laszlo Berdo, Kati Mayo and Patricia McBride. Over the span of four years with Charlotte Ballet, Juan was promoted to Charlotte Ballet II under the direction of Hope Muir and Christopher Stuart, and eventually received a promotion to the first company under Alejandro Cerrudo. With Charlotte Ballet he had the opportunity to perform pieces from innovative choreographers, the likes of Christopher Stuart, Helen Pickett, Jennifer Archibald, George Balanchine and Matthew Hart. Juan currently is in his first season as a company dancer with the Alabama Ballet under the direction of Christopher Stuart. Since moving to Alabama Juan has danced many famous works and ballets from "Giselle" to Twyla Tharp's "Sinatra Songs".



#### KATIE DROZD Guest Artist

Katie Drozd's passion for dance was sparked at a young age when she began ballet classes at a local dance studio in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. She continued her training at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts (UNCSA) for both their high school and college program. 


